# K-3: POET'S GARDEN:

Related academic subjects: fine arts, language arts, and social studies.

- I. Write down words or sentences on pieces of paper that relate to your unit of study (rhyming words, colors, animals, etc.).
- 2. Glue to pieces of paper to make leaves or flowers. Cut cardboard "stems."
- 3. Vase: Cut slits in bottom of coffee cup & insert stems. (Alternative: use a toilet paper roll for the vase.)
- 4. Insert stems into slits and glue leaves & flowers on.
- 5. Decorate vase with fabric, paper, markers, etc.

### **MATERIALS:**


- I. Disposable coffee cup or toilet paper roll

- 7. Fabric, dryer lint, markers, etc. for decorating









